

MARINE CONTRACTOR RULES & REGULATIONS



The Marine Contractor agrees:

1. To sign this Marina Agreement
2. To provide a certificate of insurance showing the following
 - a. \$1,000,000 limit per occurrence of one of the following (marine liability) [certificate to specify type & limit]
 - Marina Operator's Legal Liability
 - Maritime P&I
 - Maritime Artesan Liability
 - Ship Repairer's Legal Liability
 - b. \$2,000,000 limit in aggregate of General Liability
 - c. Workers' Compensation coverage (as appropriate)
 - d. Pollution coverage or chemical spill protection (as appropriate)
 - e. **The Gangplank Marina listed as an "additional insured"**
3. To produce certificates showing training courses to satisfy OSHA, MOSH or EPA (if requested)
4. To follow Marina working hours, which are as follows:
 - Weekdays: 7:30 am to 6:00 pm
 - Weekends: 9:00 am to 5:00 pm (no power tool usage before 11:00 am)
5. To supply written proof of boat owner's permission to work on the boat
6. To sign in with the Security Office for each boat (rather than each day) on which they plan to work
7. Not to use spray equipment in the Marina (all painting must be rolled or brushed)
8. To use dustless sanders and saws on any job that is outside of a vessel
9. Not to work on piers, use the pier as a workbench, or block or damage piers at any time
10. To hold The Gangplank Marina harmless from actions of third parties brought as a result of acts of the contractor
