



Inspector must be an accredited member of SAMS, NAMS, US Surveyors, or ABYC standards.

As appropriate, all systems need to be in compliance with:

- NFPA (National Fire Protection Association)
- USCG Title 33 & 46 CFR (Code of Federal Regulations)
- ABYC (American Boat & Yacht Council)
- Wharf Gangplank Marina Rules & Regulations

MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS

A Survey quality inspection of the following systems:

- AC & DC electrical systems (*condition of wiring, compliance with industry standards*)
- MSD – Marine Sanitation Device (*must be MSD Type III*)
- Liquid fuel heating & cooking systems (*compliance with industry standards*)
- *Fire extinguishers and fire suppression systems*
 - Marina Requires:*
 - *Proper number for size of vessel*
 - *Proper type for marine use*
 - *Gauge in green*
 - *Mounted*
 - *Accessible*
- Fuel systems (*condition of fuel lines, compliance with industry standards*)
- Smoke detector (GPM requirement)
- Carbon monoxide detector (GPM requirement)
- Presence of oil absorbent pad(s) in bilge (*GPM requirement-under oil pan of each engine generator*)

For Dockage at Gangplank, a safety inspection must be “Dock Master Approved”

A “Dock Master Approved” safety inspection is one that:

1. Has been prepared as noted above
2. Is no older than two years
3. Has been submitted to the Dock Master for review
4. The Dock Master has reviewed and identified required repairs
5. The Slipholder has completed the identified required repairs and provided written evidence to the Dock Master of their completion (DM may choose to physically inspect the vessel), and
6. The Dock Master has given a final “OK” on the given inspection and/or repairs
